Rules Corner

Rule 6-2b says the teeing area extends from the tee markers' front edge closest to the front of the tee box and back two club lengths (8feet). The sides are defined by the outside edges of the tee markers.



What happens if you tee off either ahead, behind or outside the edges of the teeing area? Stroke Play:

The original stroke is canceled, you incur a 2 stroke penalty and must re-tee from the correct area. You're hitting 3 when you re-tee the correct area.

Match Play:

Your opponent has the option of canceling your stroke and having you re-tee from the correct teeing ground area or have you play the tee shot you hit from the wrong area. There is no penalty.
