FORMAT:

Senior Division – 36-hole Stroke Play; field cut to low 24 + ties after the first round
Super-Senior Division – 36-hole Stroke Play; field cut to low 1/3 after the first round
Mid-Master Division – 36-hole Stroke Play; field cut to low 1/3 after the first round

This will be a GROSS event ONLY

REGISTRATION: Players are to report to their assigned starting tees, ready to play, 10 minutes before their starting time. **There will be no formal check-in or call to the tee.**

STARTING TIMES: First Round (Monday) tee times will begin at 8:00 a.m. off No. 1. Second Round (Tuesday) tee times will begin at 8:00 a.m. off No. 1. Starting times & groupings can be [FOUND HERE](#).

TIES: In the event of a tie for champion in any of the divisions, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff immediately after scores are finalized.

PRIZES: The Champion of the Senior, Super-Senior, and Mid-Master Championship Divisions will receive a crystal trophy. Appropriate prizes will also be awarded to low finishers in each division.

DMDS: The use of distance-measuring devices (DMD) to measure distance only (Rule 4.3) is permitted in this MSGA championship.

PACE OF PLAY: It is a condition that player must play without undue delay and in accordance with guidelines established by committee. Guidelines will be distributed upon arrival at the course.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Practice rounds can be arranged by calling the golf shop at (410) 363-0433 and will be subject to availability. Please be aware this is a busy week at the host site and their staff will do their very best to accommodate practice rounds. The rate for practice rounds will be a reciprocal fee of \$50.

PRACTICE FACILITIES/RANGE BALLS: The practice range opens one hour before the first starting time, weather permitting. Range balls will be set up at the practice range and are complimentary for competitors before the round or a play-off. As the driving range is across the street from the starting tee, please allow time to get from the range to No. 1.

CADDIES: Caddies are permitted; however, you are responsible for making your own arrangements for a caddie.

CARTS: Automotive transportation is permitted for players and caddies. **Carts are included in the entry fee.** *A player and his caddie may ride in a golf cart during a round, but both may not ride at the same time.*

Spectator Carts will not be permitted except for a spectator who can provide an issued and active Handicap Permit.

CODE OF CONDUCT: As set forth in the MSGA application, the code of conduct applies to all MSGA Qualifying and Championships.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE: Contestants and caddies must be neat in appearance. Blue jeans, designer jeans, t-shirts, and tank tops are prohibited. Shorts must be mid-thigh. Golf shirts with a traditional or mock collar are required.

FOOD SERVICE: Food service will be available as follows -

Monday – The **Halfway House** will operate from 9:45a until 5:00p and will offer a menu of hamburgers, hot dogs, cups of chicken salad and tuna salad, chips, and assorted drinks. The **Clubhouse Patio** will operate from 11:30a until 2:30p and will offer a menu of turkey wrap sandwiches, roast beef wrap sandwiches, chips, assorted drinks.

Tuesday – The **Halfway House** will operate from 10:00a until 3:00p. **Bar Service on the Patio** will begin at 11:30a and run until 30 minutes following the conclusion of the tournament.

*For both days, the club will accept **CASH or CHARGE BACK** to clubs with a reciprocity agreement with GSVHC. Credit cards will NOT be accepted.*
