## The Rules Corner

The Teeing area is treated different under the rules.....it just is.

For starters, you are allowed to tee up the ball there, and nowhere else, right? If you want to create some irregularity of surface by pressing down on the ground behind the tee, that's kosher too. So, let's leave the tee box out of this because, once we're past that, we are playing the ball as it lies.

A player is allowed to lightly ground the club right in front of or behind the ball, which means just setting it down enough to support its weight. If that's all the player is doing, even if it creates an improvement to the lie there is no penalty--see rule 8.1(b). If However the player goes beyond that (say tapping to mush-mush-mushing) and creates an improvement, under rule 8.1(a) it's the general penalty of two strokes in stroke play and loss of hole in match play.
