Membership updating the open Tee Times.

CWGC would like to move to allowing the MEMBERS to make changes ,additions and cancellations to their own tee time prior to the playdate. To do this, you must be able to log in to the GG App or Golf Genius site with your email and password. Golf Genius will be able to identify you and allow you to change “YOU” on the tee sheets.

NOTE: The initial signup will still be done as it is today; email 16 days prior on Sunday at 7am. The Tee Sheet will be built by a Sweeps Team member and then opened to the Member Portal for membership access and updates.

We are anticipating this to happen in the near future. The exact details will be sent in another newsletter dedicated to that happening. **BUT FIRST** - anyone that would like to take advantage of being able to update their own tee time must move to logging in with their email and password. The rest will still be able to email for changes. Using the email method may make it more difficult to get that open spot because an online member may get there first.

The GGID will still be made available in the Tip Sheet for scoring but you will not be able to access any open tee times with a GGID.

All Coronado Women’s Golf Club members have been registered with both the CWGC 2026 Sweeps League and the CWGC 2026 Sunday Funday League. After selecting the League, you can enter scores for an event you are playing in, look at tee times, see results and access other information on the Member Portal for each League. When you log into the GG App on your mobile device, you will be presented with those two leagues and any others that you may have played in during the current year.

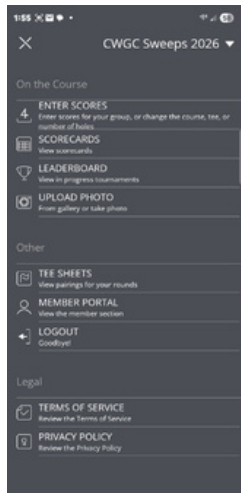
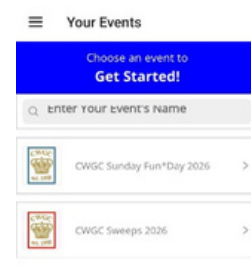
CWGC would like to begin transitioning to use of the email and password to access scoring. So - please try to log into the GG App or www.golfgenius.com with your email that received this newsletter. There will be a “forgot your password?” link that will walk you through changing your password if needed. We have board members and others that are willing to stay after playing on Tuesdays to assist everyone to get this working. Use a password you will remember. HINT: I remember my GHIN number (or part of it)!

There are some members that did not complete their registration and would have issues with this. Please send an email to cwgc.teetimes@gmail.com if the password reset does not get you into the GG App.

Board members and others have volunteered to stay around on Tuesday’s to help get everyone interested set up!



Once you are logged in, you will receive this Events Menu. Select the one you are interested in. Most of you will select Sweeps. Some will need both. Due to the extensive waiting list with the Sunday Funday, we do not anticipate allowing member changes to the Funday Tee Sheet at this time.



Once a League is selected, you will get this menu. If you have scored in GG before, you should be familiar with this one! The access for the open Tee Times will be in the Member Portal. Take this time to look around there. There are lots of other good things there too, like the membership roster list with emails and phone numbers!

The email and password can also be used to access the Member Portal from any computer browser at www.golfgenius.com. Again, this will give you access to a lot of information on the Member Portal including player statistics and league standings. The login at a computer will look like this. To access the Tee Sheets you would use the “Go to Portal” on the right side under “Actions”.
