EMGA Membership Meeting Minutes

President Larry Walker opened the Membership meeting at 1320 hrs and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance. Larry then stated there are three executive positions that have met their two-year term limits and need to be filled for next year, the President, Vice President and Treasurer. He then called for nominations.

President – John Hayes nominated Don Knight
Vice President – No nominations received at this meeting
Treasurer – Larry Walker nominated John Hayes for another term

Larry stated nominations would be accepted through September right up to the Fall membership meeting at which time the membership will vote on the named nominees. He also stated that the Webmaster Mo Hall will be stepping down and asked if anyone wanted to volunteer to let him know.

Vice President Don Knight called for nominations for the following awards:

Significant Contribution Award - recognizing an individual EMGA member or non-member who made a noticeable impact or significant contribution to the EMGA during an individual season. A member may receive this award multiple times.

Distinguished Service Award – recognizing an individual current or past member of the EMGA for sustained outstanding service to the EMGA for several years. A person may only receive this award once

Nominations are due to Don NLT the 3rd week in August, to be awarded at the Fall membership meeting in September.

Treasurer John Hayes stated that the EMGA is on-budget and estimates there will be surplus of about \$400-\$500 as expected. He also mentioned that the cashless system seems to be working well. The balance sheet Larry sends out should be keeping everyone informed of their balance. Excess money will be either paid to the individual at the end of the year, rolled over to next year, or transferred to member's EGC account to be spent by 31 December. If our members want to compete for the remaining OPCs and Tournament Skins through the end of our season, their accounts will need to have about \$100 in them.

Home and Away Mark Dalzell stated H&A matches are going well. He mentioned there will not be a match with Broadmoor Country Club. However, they have agreed to let our H&A group play. He asked if anyone had other golf clubs they would like to play to let him know.

Larry brought up pace of play. Recent OPCs have shown that 4:10 – 4:20 rounds are possible. It is up to each member to make sure they are keeping pace and encourage their playing partners to do the same. A suggestion from the floor was made to assign a “captain” for each foursome as in the H&A. However, it was emphasized that it is each member's responsibility. Larry mentioned that it is too late this year, but the EMGA should consider shotgun starts for OPCs in July and August of next year.

No new business was brought up.

President Walker closed the meeting 1340 hrs.
