### MEET SDCWGA'S NEW TEAM PLAY CO-DIRECTOR ANH-CHI FUREY



Golf has been one long love affair for me. I used to be someone who would drive by those vast expanses of green, see tiny figures swinging clubs and throwing their arms up in frustration, and remark, "Why would anyone waste an entire day doing...that?"

Fast forward to my now-ex-boyfriend convincing me to play *Tiger Woods* on the PlayStation with him, and I fell instantly and irrevocably in love with golf. It was very easy to pipe a 450-yard drive down the Old Course at St Andrews by mashing the right combination of buttons or dunk a ball from the tee on Pebble Beach #7 by spinning it in midair. How hard could it possibly be in real life?

It was, in fact, extremely hard in real life. I shot a 138 in my second-ever 18-hole round at Torrey Pines South, with nothing longer than a 7-iron, one day after Rocco and Tiger faced off in their playoff. And yet, I stayed in love with golf. I had never been able to do anything remotely athletic, and the fact that I could even get a ball airborne felt miraculous. I'm not large or strong, but I love to study, and golf is a deeply cerebral game that rewards thoughtfulness and patience.

Golf is also an excellent barometer for personality. I often suggested it as a first date, because I could learn everything I needed to know about a man's integrity, humility, temperament, love for animals—and especially how he reacted if I put it closer than him on a par 3. There were a lot of first dates. There were very, very few second dates.

Then I met Ryan in 2013 at Admiral Baker. He noticed me chipping balls onto the putting green, less than four feet away from a prominently posted NO CHIPPING sign. (He really, really doesn't like breaches of golf etiquette.) After he approached me, my first question was, "What do you normally shoot?" When he answered, "About even par," I asked for his number.

Eight golf dates and eight days later, I told a friend he was The One. Our wedding wasn't a traditional ceremony; it was a golf tournament at Steele Canyon, largely so that all of the guests could do something fun that didn't involve looking at me. Our "first dance" was simultaneous bride/groom tee shots across the canyon on Canyon #7, wearing golf shoes and gloves.
