INDIVIDUAL MODIFIED STABLEFORD RULES

TOURNAMENT SPECIFIC:

Format: Golfers will play their own ball from tee until holed. Stableford points will be awarded based on the net score for each hole. Point values awarded will be 1 point for a net bogey, 2 points for a net par, 4 points for a net birdie, 6 points for a net eagle, 8 points for a net double eagle, and 10 points for a net triple eagle or better.

Scoring: Golfers will be flighted by Tee Division and handicap index. The White Division includes players with declared tees of White and White/Gold. The Gold Division includes players with declared tees of Gold, Gold/Silver, and Silver. The top finishers in each flight will be determined by the highest number of Stableford points and will receive payouts. Ties will be retained.

Your tee assignments are marked on your scorecard. You must play from those tees.

We'll be using the Golf Genius Mobile Scoring app and a paper scorecard. **Enter only GROSS scores.** One foursome member will enter the gross scores for all four players on the GG app. A different foursome member will enter gross scores for all four players on the paper scorecard. At the end of the round, the foursome will compare the scores in Golf Genius app with the scores on the paper scorecard to validate the scores are correct on both cards. Two foursome members must sign the paper scorecard.

After completing the scoring validation, turn in your paper scorecard to a Tournament Committee (TC) member upstairs in the clubhouse. The TC will check both your paper scorecard and your mobile entry scores before you leave. If you have any questions, please ask that person. Once you leave the Clubhouse area, USGA rules prohibit any changes to the card or electronic scores. **Failure to do so will result in a DQ for the foursome.**

If a player picks up on a hole, record an "X" for that hole. If you do take an X, you will remain in the tournament, but receive no points for that hole.

Handicap (HC): Players will receive 100% of their Course HC.

Closets-to-the-Pin on Par 3s: Included.

Skins: Optional skins are \$5 per player, which includes entry into both gross and net skins. Gross skins are scored by Tee. Net skins are scored by Tee Division.

Ringers and Ike Cup: This tournament will count toward the Ringers and Ike Cup season long tournaments. However, if you record an "X", you will not have a valid score for Ike Cup qualification.

GENERAL:

KEEP UP WITH THE GROUP AHEAD OF YOU. If there is an open hole ahead of you, you are behind. Please pick up your pace. USGA rules and Eisenhower local rules apply to include only 3 mins to look for a lost ball. However, the EMGA Board has elected not to use the EGC alternate lost ball local rule for any of its events **so if in doubt, please play a provisional.**

Ground Under Repair must be marked. Damaged areas not marked are NOT GUR.
