

EMGA 2026 TWO-MAN SCRAMBLE RULES

TOURNAMENT SPECIFIC:

- Format: Both players will tee off on each hole from their declared tees, and the team will choose which drive to use. Both players will then play each shot in a traditional scramble format until holed. **The Team must use at least three drives from each team member on Holes 1-9 and three drives from each member on Holes 10-18. These are not necessarily your first nine holes and your last nine holes.**

- **Mark the player whose tee shot is used for each hole on the paper scorecard. Failure to do so will result in a team disqualification.**

- This is a true Scramble -- if you decide to tap in and hole your putt before your partner putts, the hole is over. If you miss your tap-in, your partner cannot take his original putt, but must play from where your missed tap-in putt stopped.

Off the green, you must place your ball within a scorecard length (same as a golf grip) from the ball selected, but you must stay in the same condition as the original shot. For example, if you are in the rough, you must stay in the rough. **On the green**, you must place the ball within one putter head, no closer to the pin, from the ball selected.

Your tee assignments are marked on your scorecard, and you must play from those tees.

We'll be using Golf Genius Mobile App along with a paper scorecard. A player from one team will log into Golf Genius using your foursome GGID and keep the electronic score for both teams. A player from the other team will keep the paper scorecard for both teams. Record the **Gross** score for each team. After the round, compare the scores between the Mobile App and the paper card to ensure they are correct. One golfer from each team must sign the paper scorecard. **Return the paper scorecard to a Tournament Committee member in the Silver dining room after your round and before you leave the clubhouse area.** Teams with no paper scorecard will be DQ'd for the tournament. In the event there is a discrepancy between the GG Mobile scorecard and the paper scorecard, the Tournament Committee will use the score marked on the paper scorecard and change the score marked in GG to match the paper scorecard.

Your team handicap is 35% of the A player's, plus 15% of the B player's course handicap.

Ties will be retained and the purse money for the tied places split among the tied teams.

If your partner has not shown by the time you complete your first hole, the team will be disqualified. You are free to go ahead and play your round, but your individual score will not be part of the tournament.

GENERAL:

KEEP UP WITH THE GROUP AHEAD OF YOU. If you have an open hole in front of you, you are behind, even if the group behind you is not pushing--please pick up your pace.

USGA rules and Eisenhower local rules apply to include only 3 mins to look for a lost ball. The EMGA Board has elected not to use the EGC alternate lost ball local rule for any of its events so if in doubt, please play a provisional.

Range finders must be set to distance only.
